- How would that show it's self in todays culture?
- Do you think most people think they are good people or sinners?
- Who does Jesus accept?
- What does it mean to you that Jesus is your friend?
- What kinds of people should we be investing in, in relation to this story?

- Who can memorise that?!
- What does it mean to you that Jesus Loved you first?
