Discuss

-  What does it mean to test words and pictures given, how could you do that?



Activity

NOW DO IT!!! Give 15 mins at least for this part.

HANDS:

You will need paper and pens

Get each person to draw round their hand. Then **turn the paper over** and write their name on it.

Spread the paper with the hands facing up around the room,

Pray that God will give us words and pictures, and encouraging things about the people in the room.

The young people then ask God to speak to them for the people in the room. They should see if they get a bible verse, a word, a sentence, a thought, picture for the hands. Write it on, and move to the next one. Don't take too long over it, write the first thing that comes to mind, as long as it is encouraging. Do as many as you can in the time. Not looking at who's hand it is. Then at the end give the hands back to the right people.

If you can spend a bit of time at the end with people sharing if there is anything that hits home or has encouraged them to the group, as hearing back that what they wrote had impact is encouraging.
