Intro



- Welcome everyone. (Make sure everyone knows each other, register etc.)
- Explain what happens at youth, and what today is about.
- Play Blind Drawing give each young person a piece of paper, and then with their eyes closed tell to draw something e.g. draw a chicken, draw a chair... and then get each young person to show their drawings.
- What good news have you received recently?
- What is the best thing ever to happened to you?
- How many people have you told that story to? How many times have you told the story?
- Would you agree that when something great happens, you want to tell others?

Bible Bit...

Four Steps to sharing your faith!



1. Tell people about God's Plan, Peace & Life Read - John 3:16



2. Share the problem - Our Sin and separation from God - Romans 3:23 & Romans 6:23



3. Talk about God's remedy - Jesus dying on the cross - 1 Peter 2:24

4. Our Response - Receiving Jesus as our Saviour - John 1:12

To Receive Jesus the person needs to do four things...

- 1. Admit they're a sinner
- 2. Ask for forgiveness and turn from sin
- 3. Believe Jesus died for you on the cross
- 4. Receive Jesus into your heart and life



Activity





Watch the 3 circles again on the video if needed.
