Bible Bit...



In the OT under the law how did the people of God atone for their sins?



- Who is John the Baptist? John the Baptist's ministry forms a hinge between the OT and the NT. He is all about repentance because we have broken God's law, and the promise of another who was coming to put it (and us) right. So he's looking back - and looking forward.
- How did John the Baptist know that Jesus is the Lamb of God?
- What did he say specifically about what the Lamb of God would do? How does this link to the OT and atonement for our sins?

- What has happened to us as a result of Jesus' sacrifice?
- Why did the priests perform the same sacrifices if they could never take away the sins of everyone? What did it point us to?

Revelation 5:12-13

Only the Lamb of God can open up heaven for us? Would you say you know him? Can you think of Heaven when we will get to worship him for ever and ever...
