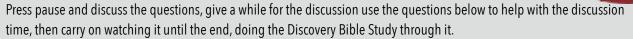

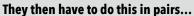

- 2. What does this story say to you about Jesus?
 - 1. Why did he not go straight away?
 - 2. Why do you think Jesus cried with them when he knew he was about to raise Lazarus from the dead?
 - 3. What does this story show you about Jesus' compassion and his power?
- 3. What does this story have to say about you?
 - 1. What do you learn about where Jesus is in your own problems?
 - 2. Who do you most relate to in the story?
 - 3. How does the story encourage or inspire you?
 - 4. How can you apply it to other things, not just death of Lazarus but other things that need bringing to life?
- 4. Who needs to hear this story?
 - 1. Who needs hope?
